



Some key facts

- support for innovation & researchoriented projects
- scaling up innovations:
 - measure impacts
 - capacity-building
 - transfer and take-up
- cooperation between public & private sector
- marketplace to improve take-up of research results
- preparing for a lasting legacy of **CIVITAS** innovations
- 4 ½ years, 3 M€ funding
- **Start: 1 July 2016**

CIVINET support through CIVITAS SATELLITE

General information

- In CAPITAL the CIVINETs had their own work package; in SATELLITE support is encompassed in multiple WPs
- SATELLITE provides **financial support** (250,000€ Activity Fund) plus prioritised access to funding of work placements and study visits
- In addition, SATELLITE provides non-financial support

CIVINET support through CIVITAS SATELLITE

Financial

- Activity Fund for existing CIVINETs (2 calls à 110,000€ each planned)
 - Activities that can be funded comprise:
 - capacity building activities (workshops, seminars, site visits, translation of ecourses/ learning material, providing expert advice to members)
 - transfer and take-up activities (peer-to-peer exchanges, translation of Thematic Group material)
 - translation of promotional material
- Activity Fund for establishment of new CIVINETs (1 call à 30,000€ planned)
- Prioritised access to funding of work placements and study visits for CIVINET members (37,200€ available in total)
 - four open calls planned
 - budget available for participants
 - budget available for host cities



CIVINET support through CIVITAS SATELLITE

Non-financial

- SATELLITE dissemination activities
 - dissemination of CIVINET news at EU level, e.g. CIVINET news in MOVE newsletter
 - regular communication with CIVINETs: dedicated information and news from CIVITAS world and projects
 - strong visibility on CIVITAS website
- Involvement in CIVITAS Thematic Groups (TGs)
 - Participation in dedicated exchange and networking in TGs
 - CIVINET members can submit specific requests to the TGs for activities catering for their specific needs, e.g. a national event on a specific topic
 - CIVINETs invited to contribute to PAC recommendations in cooperation with TGs
- Access to marketplace of transport tools, methodologies and solutions
- Provision of Exchange Hub for CIVINET-internal communication
- Access to SATELLITE's capacity building activities, e.g. e-learning courses, webinars, etc.
- SATELLITE will conduct surveys with CIVINETs to identify further support needs and expectations
