EU funding

EU funding opportunities are rather diverse. To the external eye, it may come over as fragmented and complex to understand. The first thing to know is that there are two broad categories of EU financial support: support for implementation (including pilot projects and feasibility studies) and support for research and innovation (including demonstrations).

When it comes to urban mobility, the most relevant sources of support for projects are:

- The European Structural and Investment Funds
- The Connecting Europe Facility (CEF) funds for Trans-European Transport Network (TEN-T)
- The European Investment Bank
 - The ELENA programme
 - The JASPERS programme
 - The European Energy Efficiency Fund
 - EIB financial products
- The INTERREG EUROPE programme
- The URBACT III programme
- Innovative actions in sustainable urban development
- The LIFE programme

As far as support for research and innovation is concerned, this is mainly the Horizon2020 programme (formally FP7) which itself includes some sub-programmes such as CIVITAS. For projects related to fuel cell and hydrogen-powered vehicles in particular, there is also the Fuel Cell and Hydrogen Joint Undertaking, a partnership between the European Commission and industry and research actors.

The SUMP process

Preparing a Sustainable Urban Mobility Plan (SUMP) is a complex undertaking. With Commission support, guidelines developed offering concrete suggestions on how to apply the SUMP concept and prepare an urban mobility strategy that builds on a clear vision for the sustainable development of an urban area.

The guidelines do not give details on the technical measures to be included in a SUMP. Instead, they describe the process of how to develop and implement such a Plan. The process comprises of 11 main steps with 32 related activities:

- 1: Determine your potential for a successful SUMP
- 2: Define the development process and scope of the plan
- 3: Analyse the mobility situation and develop scenarios
- 4: Develop a common vision
- 5: Set priorities and measurable targets
- 6: Develop effective packages of measures
- 7: Agree on clear responsibilities and allocate budgets
- 8: Build systems for monitoring and assessment into the plan
- 9: Adopt the SUMP
- 10: Ensure proper management and communication (when implementing the plan)
- 11: Learn the lessons

Each step of this process is illustrated in the guidelines, with good practice examples, tools and references to further information.

The guidelines are intended for local authorities, urban transport and mobility practitioners, as well as other stakeholders involved in the preparation of a SUMP.

The guidelines are the result of a review of existing documents and a thorough and European-wide expert consultation process organised between 2010 and 2013 as part of a service contract for the European Commission.
